Dr. Adriaens is Professor of Civil and Environmental Engineering, and Professor of Entrepreneurship and Strategy in the Ross School of Business, where he is affiliated with the Zell Lurie Institute for Entrepreneurial Studies. He is past-President of the Association of Environmental Science and Engineering Professors, a member-by-eminence of the American Academy of Environmental Engineering (AAEE), and Member of the Belgian Royal

Academy of Applied Sciences, where he was recognized for bridging engineering and business entrepreneurship in academia and practice. From 2014-2016, he is a Finnish Distinguished Professor, focused on the design of Multi-Asset Investment Funds for Industrial Renewal, in collaboration with the Research Institute for the Finnish Economy, institutional investors and policymakers.

Following a 20-year career in environmental technology development and validation, his current work focuses on CleanTech innovation and entrepreneurship. Specific interests include corporate and financial risk models, reverse innovation strategies, and the design of indexes and investment portfolios for emerging sustainable industries, particularly with focus on water. He teaches courses on Business Models, Entrepreneurial Business Fundamentals, CleanTech Ventures, and Environmental Finance. He is co-developer of the KeyStone Compact™, a data-driven analytical and strategic positioning tool for global early and later stage companies in a wide range of investment domains.
